Comprehension

- Informational (ASSESSMENT - FRIDAY - LAST READING ASSESSMENT FOR THE YEAR!!!!)

Writing (ASSESSMENT - THIS WEEK)

- I can participate in shared research and writing projects (e.g., read a number of books on a single topic to produce a report; record science observations).

***How You Can Help Your Child: Work with your child to research a topic of your child's choosing and write about that topic.

Grammar

- There will be NO more grammar assessments for the rest of the year. We are going to review standards taught this year and enrich with standards taught in 3rd grade. :)

Math

- Module 8
 - I can recognize and draw shapes having specified attributes, such as a given number of angles or a given number of equal faces. Identify triangles, quadrilaterals, pentagons, hexagons, and cubes.
 - I can partition circles and rectangles into two, three, or four equal shares, describe the shares using the words halves, thirds, half of, a third of, etc., and describe the whole as two halves, three thirds, four fourths. Recognize that equal shares of identical wholes need not have the same shape.

***How You Can Help Your Child: Talk to your child about how he/she solved the problems on their Exit Ticket.

Science

- There will be NO more science assessments for the rest of the year. We are going to review standards taught this year and enrich with standards taught in 3rd grade. :)
